- 1. Welcome and introductions:** Chris Herzog, Ramon and Eva Walters welcomed to the committee. CH and R will jointly do IT. EW offered to be church and community outreach member and shadow AN to potentially take on class rep co-ord in Sept.
- 2. Minutes of last meeting** – Agreed. Xmas Fair raised approx £730 for Gatehouse (to be match funded by Council). NNS date discussed, either shift to Autumn or not hold this year if a volunteer to lead is not forthcoming.
- 3. February Quiz Night – 7<sup>th</sup> Feb** – The Griffiths will run the event. Jaqueline will apply for alcohol licence and ask The Standard about food. JB to ask Waste to Taste. Tickets on sale from 15<sup>th</sup> Jan. (*afternote – W2T keen but unavailable. Standard providing food. PTA Committee making deserts*)
- 4. Book Day** – Jaqueline to ask for the head's opinion on the possibility of a book day to involve local authors, especially parents who are authors, in a day focused on enthusing children about books.
- 5. Fair trade School** – JB has been asked if we could consider becoming a FairTrade school. This would involve PTA and staff in buying Fairtrade and involving this in the school curriculum. JM to discuss with head re possibility of appointing a FairTrade rep to meet with local organisation and take this forward. - 6. Lost Property** – Sarah Griffiths has offered to sort the lost property. KC offered to help and to use the rails to display it so that it can be claimed more easily. Remainder to go to charity.

  - a.** Comms – need to be clearer. EW pointed out the benefits of community engagement fostered through the PTA to the SIAMS and OFSTED assessments (British Values). Eg. Having raised money for the Gatehouse, we could gain additional benefit by incorporating into assembly etc to reinforce links to community. Closer comms with PTA/school staff might help facilitate this.
